
WHAT TO EXPECT WHEN BUYING BEGINNING THE SEARCH




Your home search has officially begun, and I look forward to working with you! Below, are important items to help you know what to expect as we go through the buying process.





Be prepared, the year is proving to be a sellersmarket. That means there are <u>many buyers and low</u> <u>inventory</u>. Low inventory can cause properties in certain neighborhoods to receive multiple offers and often homes sell in the first week. I'm not telling you this to be discouraging, but to prepare you for a competitive market situation (which means if something you love comes on the market, you have to be prepared to make an offer). That said, as more inventory comes on the market it may get less competitive.
